For your arrows have sunk into me, and your hand has come down on me.** There is no soundness in my flesh because of your indignation; there is no health in my bones because of my sin. **For my iniquities have gone over my head; like a heavy burden, they are too heavy for me.** But for you, O Lord, do I wait; it is

you, O Lord my God, who will answer. I confess my iniquity; I am sorry for my sin. Do not forsake me, O Lord! O my God, be not far from me! Make haste to help me, O Lord, my salvation!

God, today we come to worship with your people plagued by the stain of sin. It's all over us, it latches on, and we can't seem to shake it off. We fall asleep with thoughts of joy on our minds, and yet we still awake in the morning selfish, lazy, rebellious, and wicked. Forgive us, Father. Father, we are people of lustful passions: prone to anger, prone to adultery, prone to covet and desire and want and long for what we think is good. We are a people who make our living in pornography, in gluttony, in spiteful gossip, in bitter unforgiveness, and in anxious, fearful, lack of faith. We repent, Lord, for all of it is idolatry. Forgive us for exchanging your truth for lies, and for sitting down to feast at any other table than the table of joyful obedience. We need you God, everyday and today, as we are weak. We need your mercy and forgiveness, as we have failed to kill sin and instead we have let it kill us. We need you God, because this week time and time again we have thought we are the masters of our own fate. Our world is full of violence and hatred—we gun each other down in our streets and in our shopping centers. All of this flows from sinful hearts. Forgive us our sins, even now, as we repent individually before you.

GOD REVEALS HIS GRACE

Assurance of Pardon

Psalm 108:8-13 The LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love. He will not always chide, nor will he keep his anger forever. He does not deal with us according to our sins, nor repay us according to our iniquities. For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his steadfast love toward those who fear him; as far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us. As a father shows compassion to his children, so the LORD shows compassion to those who fear him.

If you have truly confessed and repented of your sins, and this morning have turned to Jesus' person and work for forgiveness, you are forgiven and all of your sin is removed.
